

Medical Requirements

Eurocontrol, the European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation, that drafts the rules concerning the Single European Sky, published a new regulation 2015/340 re-examining the technical requirements and administrative procedures relating to air traffic controllers' licences.

In <u>Annex 4</u>, Section 2 of this regulation named the "Requirements for class 3 medical certificates" candidates can retrieve the requirements they must fulfil in order to qualify for the job of air traffic controller:

As a future potential air traffic controller you must meet the requirements set in the aforementioned Regulation. Therefore a medical examination is part of the exam procedure.

Since the medical requirements for air traffic controllers are very strict, we advise you to carefully read the document above before enrolling.

Blood, blood pressure, lung capacity, nose-ear-throat, hearing, eye sight, etc. will be tested. You may want to contact your own GP / ophthalmologist if you have any doubts about qualifying for this medical exam.
