

What do the colors of a geozone mean in Droneguide Map?

Droneguide Map has several ways of indicating geozones:

- Zone colored in **red**
 - The area displayed in red indicates an active geozone. To check the access conditions for the specific active geozone, click on the geozone name in the left column.
- Zone colored in **yellow**
 - The areas displayed in yellow indicate a geozone that will be activated or temporarily reserved later during the (current) day.
- Zone with **red border/frame**
 - These are inactive geozones. You are able to view the geozone conditions that are applicable, but you do not need to adhere to these at the current time, as the zone is inactive. These zones are indicated on the map to inform drone operator/pilot's that this geozone is something to be aware of when planning an operation in the future. As stated before, as long as these zones are indicated with a red border/frame or in yellow, these zones are not active, and thus the conditions of the zone do not need to be followed at this point in time.
- Zone with **no color/transparent**
 - No geozone conditions are active here.
